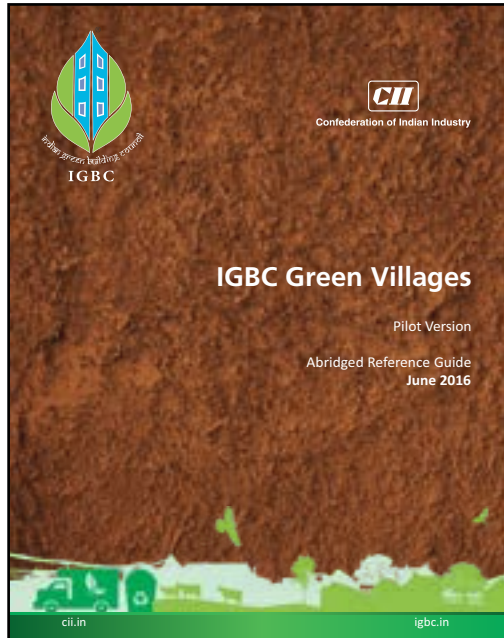


IGBC GREEN VILLAGES
